



## Catch Up Funding Strategy 2015-2016

### *Overview of Impact*

This document outlines the impact of the Catch Up funding for Year 7 students totalling £16500 for 2015-2016.

- Number of students eligible for catch up funding for English or Maths: 29
- Number of students eligible for catch up funding for English only: 16
- Number of students eligible for catch up funding for Maths only: 20
- Number of students eligible for catch up funding for English and Maths: 10

Additional staffing in English to provide TA support in lessons for targeted students.	£8500	7/16 students in English made at least expected progress during. 1 student made 5 sub levels of progress in English improving from a 2b - 4c. 1 student made 4 sub levels of progress in English improving from a 2a – 4c.
Additional staffing in maths to provide focused support for basic numeracy development through small group interventions and in lesson support.	6500	17/20 students in maths made at least expected progress. 2 students made 4 sub levels of progress in maths.
Resources to support literacy and numeracy sessions.	£1500	8 students made 3 sub levels of progress in maths.

**Evaluation**

The Catch Up funding during 2015-2016 had greater impact with students in mathematics evidenced by a greater proportion of targeted students making at least expected progress (2 sub levels from starting point) and reaching level 4 at the end of Year 7. As a result a thorough analysis of the deployment of funding in English took place during the summer term to inform how the funds will be deployed for 2016-2017.
