Final week for Year 11: 7th-11th June 2021

I am writing to outline plans for the last week of compulsory attendance for Year 11, which will see the final gathering of evidence for Teacher Assessed Grades and a celebration for the cohort of their time at Six Villages, as we say good-bye to them on Friday 11th June.

Monday 7th June to Wednesday 9th June: there will be a final collection of evidence to support Teacher Assessed Grades on these days. It is essential that all students attend on these days to ensure that all our students have had a fair chance to complete final assessments and that any evidence that can support their Teacher Assessed Grades has been collected.

We are also happy to support transition to Sixth Form for those students who have been invited to their next education providers; however, students should ensure that they liaise with their teachers to discuss any pending work.
