# **Free School Meals**

### **Lateral Flow Testing**

I have received an update from Gavin Williamson, Secretary of State for Education, emphasising the importance of staff and students continuing to test twice weekly and prevent the spread of the virus. Please remind your child of the need to record the test on <a href="https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result">https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result</a>. The data I receive for Six Villages' lateral flow testing indicates that not all students are recording their tests.

If the test is positive, you must self-isolate as per government guidelines, and take a confirmatory PCR Test. All close contacts must self-isolate as well as per government guidelines. If they have symptoms/positive test within 48 hours of leaving school (so up till Sunday afternoon) the school should be notified.

All other protective measures remain in place and regular rapid testing will continue to help find and isolate asymptomatic cases when they do occur. This is particularly important now with impact the Delta variant has had on some areas.
