Year 8 Reward Event - 20th July 2021

As part of our whole school rewards system, Ormiston Six Villages Academy organises an annual year group reward trip in the summer term. The aim of the trip is to reward students who have consistently met our expectations in terms of work-rate, effort, attendance and behaviour. Due to the Covid restrictions, we have taken the decision to bring the Year 8 reward to the academy this year.

I am therefore inviting Year 8 students with attendance of 95% and above and over 750 reward points to be able to participate in this event. Following discussion with students we have arranged for Laser Tag, Human Table Football and an 8m rock climbing wall. An external company is coming to the academy field to set up these exciting activities. This will complement the development of interpersonal skills and resilience. Students will have at least one hour on each activity.

Your child's tutor will be discussing the number of reward points students have, and their attendance. Reward point totals can also be accessed through Satchel one. We want to ensure as many as possible are eligible for this opportunity.

This activity will require your child to wear their P.E kit and suitable trainers. As we will be outside for much of the day, please ensure your child brings a high factor sun cream (SPF30 or above) for the day and plenty to drink.

We invite those whose child is eligible for this reward and who would like their child to participate in these activities to make a voluntary contribution of £18.00. As the school would not be able to bear any of the cost of this event without affecting other areas of our provision, the event may not take place unless all parents who are able are willing to contribute. If you are unable to contribute, please contact me in confidence.

If you wish your child to participate, please pay the full amount of £18.00 on Parent Pay, by **Friday 25th June 2021.** If your child becomes ineligible for the trip as a result of a poor behaviour log, regrettably you will not be entitled to a refund as the academy will still be required to pay for your child's place.

Students not eligible, or those who opt not to attend the reward event, will be required to attend school as normal, wearing full school uniform, where a productive and appropriate series of activities will be undertaken.
