Covid measures

Following the advice from the WSCC Director of Public Health that headteachers should reintroduce the requirement for students to wear face coverings in communal areas, may I ask for your assistance with the following:

- To ensure your child is provided with two facemasks, one to use and a spare in their bag.
- To provide your child with a small bottle of personal sanitiser that they bring to school and use regularly each day.
- Please have a conversation with your child if they travel on public transport that it is now (again)
 mandatory to wear face coverings on buses, trains etc. and ensure they have a face covering and wear
 it for the duration of the journey.

As you may already be aware, West Sussex is now an area of high prevalence for Covid 19 and I would appreciate your support in helping me to keep our community safe.

Lateral Flow Test Programme – January 2022

The latest guidance from the DfE is for schools to undertake rapid asymptomatic testing of students when they return to school after the Christmas holidays in January. Students will take <u>one</u> test in school and a second test at home three to four days later. The DfE view is that on-site testing at the start of term will reduce transmission and play a vital role in keeping Covid out of schools.

Therefore, please note the following:

- all students who have previously participated in the academy's asymptomatic testing programme will be tested in January, unless consent is withdrawn in writing.
- Students for whom we do not have consent will not be tested but should attend school as usual.
- Students who have joined the academy since the last testing programme re invited to complete the electronic consent form. Please contact Mrs Canadas on ccs@ormistonsixvillages.org.uk if this applies to your child.
- There is no staggered start to term. All students start the Spring term on Wednesday 5th January and will be tested on that day.
- Tuesday 4th January is an INSET day.
