Remembrance

This week at school, students have had assemblies marking 100 years of the British Legion. Yesterday, the whole academy observed the Act of Remembrance including two minutes' silence in the courtyard. I would like to thank the students who participated in readings and Joshua for playing The Last Post.

In their History classes, some students have shown an interest in finding out if any of their relatives died in the service of Great Britain. We would like to direct any enquiring minds to the Commonwealth War Graves Commission website - https://www.cwgc.org/find-records/find-war-dead/ - which has a search function where you can trace surnames and places of origin. Year 11 PPE Exams

The vast majority of exams are now complete. Some 'mop up' exams for students who have missed exams over the last two weeks will take place next week. The Drama exam has been rescheduled to Thursday 25th November and students have been advised of this.

The exams took place within exam conditions with invigilators to give students a real experience of what to expect in their actual public examinations in the summer term.

Dance Club

Please note that Tuesday after school dance club will not take place for the next two weeks. There are a number of other clubs students are welcome to attend instead.

Data Collection Sheets

Periodically we issue student data collection sheets to parents and carers to review and amend as necessary. It is very important that the academy holds accurate student data, particularly parent contact details. Year 11 data collection sheets were issued today and Year 10 and 8 sheets will be issued next week. Please review, sign and ask your child to return the sheet to reception as soon as possible.

Covid Vaccinations for 12-15 year olds

A confirmed date is now scheduled for a visit from the School Age Immunisation team on 22nd November. The information, including the link to the consent form, was issued to parents earlier this week and the documents are reattached with this letter. I would urge you to note the deadline for providing/not providing consent of **11am 1 working day before** the session, as this cannot be extended.
