Year 11 Summer 2022 exams

The latest DfE guidance states the following:

"Assessments in secondary schools and colleges

It is the government's intention that GCSE, A level and other exams will go ahead in summer 2022. Exams and assessments for vocational and technical qualifications will take place, in line with the latest guidelines, throughout the next academic year." Click <u>here</u> to view the full guidance.

We are therefore anticipating that Summer 2022 exams will go ahead as planned. Following the first set of mock exams in November, students have received feedback from subject teachers on what to work on and how to improve their grades. Please encourage your child to spend some time reviewing/revising their subjects, to continue to work towards the next set of formal assessments starting in February 2022. In view of National Plan B, the DfE has issued guidance entitled 'what parents and carers need to know about early years providers, schools and colleges'...

Year 8 and 9 HPV Vaccinations

The vaccinations are taking place on Friday 7th January 2022. The e-consent system will be open over the Christmas period closing the week before school reopens. Please complete the consent form to record either that you wish your child to be vaccinated or that you do not provide consent.

Lateral Flow Testing

A reminder that all students, who usually participate in the lateral flow testing programme, will have their LFT on the first day of term (Wednesday 5th January). In line with guidance, students who we have on record as having had Covid in the 90 days leading to the test day will not be called for a LFT.
