Year 11 Arrangements

I am writing to advise of arrangements for the remainder of Year 11 and would ask that you read the content of this letter carefully.

- **Friday 27th May**

All students have a Chemistry exam tomorrow morning. After the exam, students may either remain in school for independent study to the end of the school day or may leave site to study independently at home. Please indicate your preference on the consent form <https://forms.office.com/r/t4qYfr1SqM>. I must stress that if we do not receive confirmation from you, we will not be able to permit your child to leave site. Should you wish for your child to remain on school site and study until the end of the school day, provision will be in place to support this.

- **After half term**

After half term, students will only be required to attend site for their exams and any lessons for subjects they have yet to take exams in. Students must plan to arrive at school in plenty of time for their exams. For a morning exam, they must arrive for 8.20am as usual; for an afternoon exam, they must be on site by 12.20pm.

If you do not wish for your child to be on study leave (off site) until the end of the formal examination period, a designated, staffed study space will be provided for students. Students wishing to attend school as usual will be required to arrive and leave in accordance with our normal school hours and will be expected to remain in their allocated study space or subject lesson at all times.

- **Thursday 23rd June**

Following the physics exam in the morning, there will be an end of year 11 celebration including a leavers' assembly, the traditional shirt signing and a surprise treat is planned.

- **Prom**

Prom tickets will be available for collection after each student's final exam. Students will be required to have completed their sign off sheet that week. Please ensure all library books are returned. If you have any surplus uniform we would gratefully receive it for our uniform shop.

We must remind you that we would like to ensure that all Six Villages core values are upheld by students up to the end of their time with us. Poor behaviour may result in the withdrawal of invitation to celebration events.
