## **RE: Consultation on admission arrangements**

I am writing to notify you of the consultation on the academy's 2025 – 26 admissions policy. The consultation period will run from 2nd October 2023 until 13th November 2023; during this time, parents and other key stakeholders are invited to express their views and any concerns about the admission arrangements at Ormiston Six Villages Academy.

In accordance with the DfE's 2021 statutory 'School Admissions Code' guidance, as a school we must consult on our admission arrangements when changes are proposed, and at least once every seven years. For this reason, a consultation is currently being held to meet the academy's statutory duty; however, it should be noted that no changes to the current admission arrangements have been proposed.

In accordance with statutory DfE guidance, the consultation will run for at least six weeks and, as an interested party at Ormiston Six Villages Academy, we are keen to hear your views on our current admission arrangements. Therefore, we invite you to participate in the consultation if you have any concerns regarding the matter.
