Important consent information for Flu vaccinations Academic Year 2023-24

The Immunisation Service are coming into school on **15th November 2023** to offer your child the Flu vaccination. Attached to this email are the following documents:

• A parent/carer letter – containing vaccination information and instructions on how to complete the online consent form. Please complete a form to either consent or refuse to your child receiving this vaccination. The online consent form is available for completion until 11am four working days before the session date above.

If you have more than one child in the same year group, but they do not attend the same school site, you will receive a separate letter from each school site, to consent for each child, prior to their school's vaccination session. Please use the correct school code for each child.

• How to consent to Flu vaccination guide – a pictorial guide to completing the online consent form.

If you have any difficulties completing the online consent form, please contact your local Immunisation Team before the cut-off date, using the telephone number provided in the attached letter, or, ask your school to notify the Immunisation Team so that we can contact you directly.

If you miss the cut off time to complete the consent form, we will not be able to vaccinate your child in school on the day of the vaccination session. The consent form will reopen one working day after the session, enabling you to submit a form for your child to be offered the vaccination, within one of our catch-up clinics.

World Mental Health Day

World mental health day was earlier this week, on 10th October. As part of supporting young people the NHS have created a series of online videos to help parents and carers support their children to manage a range of mental health conditions, which are now available.

Arun and Chichester Citizens Advice Cost of Living Survey

Arun and Chichester Citizens Advice have launched the 'Cost of Living Survey 2023'. The purpose of this annual survey is to understand the impact the cost-of-living crisis is having on Arun and Chichester residents, including on their physical and mental health, and to be able to compare these with last year's findings. The responses received help us to tailor our service to meet these needs. We would like to gain a representative sample from all sections of our community.

What parents and carers need to know about WIZZ

This week's national online security focus is WIZZ, which is a networking app which allows users to connect and chat with other people around the world. The principal of it is similar to a dating platform and conversations can be initiated through the instant messaging.



The poster below summaries the many risks to WIZZ:

- Young people tend to be more trusting online and may share personal information to strangers
- The system only detects approximate age, so an older person who *looks* younger could be grouped with teens (or vice versa)
- Profile pictures don't have to match the face of the person who did the initial age verification so fake accounts using other people's photos could be set up
- People can be coaxed into sending sexually suggestive images of themselves
- There is no evidence of parental controls or safety features
- Research has evidenced users being encouraged to connect on other social media swapping nude or seminude pictures or holding sexual chats giving an impression of the platform being sleazy and unsafe for young people.

I would urge you to follow the advice for parents and carers in the poster at the end of this letter.
