Dear Parents and Carers,

Women's FA Cup Final Trip - 11/05/24 or 12/05/24 (For students of all year groups)

The PE department are delighted to announce the opportunity for students to attend this season's Women's FA Cup Final at Wembley Stadium!

This is a fantastic opportunity for all students that have been inspired by the Lionesses in recent years or for those that are already avid fans of Women's football to attend a match in which our nation's club elite teams compete for the historic trophy.

Currently the FA have not confirmed whether the final will take place on either Saturday 11th or Sunday 12th May, so we are asking those that are interested to ensure they are available for both provisional dates. Timings of the day will be confirmed nearer the time.

Costing:

The cost requirements are detailed below, however, please be aware that the cost of the coach is currently a quote estimate and on the assumption the coach is filled, therefore the price may be subject to a change until confirmation of the date is released. Once we have confirmed the number of students that have paid the deposit, we will then provide a final confirmation of price to allow parents to make a final decision before non-refundable payments are made.

What you need to do next

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, please complete the Parent Pay form online by 31st October. Deposits will be required, which is included in the Parent Pay form. Please note that once deposits have been paid to the respective companies and tickets have been purchased, these are non-refundable, and terms and conditions will apply.

We invite those who would like their child to participate in the trip to make a voluntary contribution as outlined above to cover the cost of transport, entry to venue and insurance. As the academy would not be able to bear any of the cost of the trip without affecting other areas of our provision, the trip may not take place unless all parents who are able are willing to contribute. If you are in receipt of income support or family credit, or feel unable to contribute, please contact Mrs Gavin in confidence. Payments to be made by ParentPay.

Cancellation

If the trip is cancelled for reasons outside our control a full refund will be given. For any other reason refunds are only processed in exceptional circumstances and at the academy's discretion. This means that if your child becomes ineligible for the trip as a result of negative behaviour at the academy, you will unfortunately not be entitled to any refund.
