Accurate Reporting of Absence

Over the last few months there has been an increasing trend of parents and carers providing reasons for their child's absence from school which are not true, which is very disappointing. It has always been my aim to develop good working relationships with parents and carers, to work in partnership to ensure the best possible outcomes for your children.

We live in an era where social media and other online systems are at the forefront of our daily lives. Students are on social media – some of them before the appropriate age – and when a child is on holiday, or on a birthday outing, or shopping, or at a Harry Styles concert to name just a few, we hear about it. If you are taking your child out of school for a planned absence during term time, please be open and honest about it and complete the request for absence form in advance.

Attendance at school has been a national priority since the pandemic and the government introduced fines in the form of fixed penalty notices to tackle unlawful absence from school, to support this priority. There are 175 non-school days every year to take holidays and arrange other family events and I would urge you to avoid absence from school during term time.

PE Kit During Winter - Guidelines and Expectations

As we are entering the colder months of the year, we want to ensure that students keep warm during PE lessons. Please read the guidelines and expectations below concerning wearing extra layers in PE lessons.

- Your child's PE kit <u>must</u> be the top layer of their clothing:
 - Upper body PE top, PE jumper, PE hoodie, PE long sleeve.
 - Lower body PE shorts, PE leggings, PE tracksuit bottoms.

What is permitted?

- Permitted upper body underlayers include: sports thermals, short sleeved t-shirts, black or blue long-sleeved t-shirts.
- Permitted body underlayers are sports thermal leggings/shorts
- Gloves <u>are permitted</u>, with a recommendation that gloves with grips are worn when participating in throwing and catching related activities outside/
- Snood/neck thermals and beanie hats are permitted.

What is not permitted?

- Coats, jackets and non-PE hoodies are not permitted
- School tights are <u>not permitted</u>. If students wear tights to school, then they must ensure they bring a pair of socks with them for PE lessons; if not, they will be provided with spare school long PE socks as an alternative.

Refusal to comply with the above guidelines will result in a department sanction and students have been made aware of this. Please discuss expectations with your child. If you have any questions, please contact Mr Dacombe, Head of PE, on mde@ormistonsixvillages.org.uk.
