West Sussex Youth Safety Survey

There is NO cap on participation - West Sussex would like as many children and young people to have an opportunity to have their voice heard and inform the way in which services respond to the issues they face in their lives, particularly in different locations in West Sussex.

We are running a survey for the West Sussex Violence Reduction Partnership (VRP) to understand young people's perspectives on living and growing up in West Sussex, including your feelings of safety.

Who can take part in this survey?

This survey is for children and young people aged 11 and above living or going to school in West Sussex (the geographic area covered by West Sussex County Council). You can access this survey online using the QR code/link below. It is best to use a digital device to complete this survey, such as a phone, tablet, laptop or computer.







What does the survey cover?

This survey takes around 10 minutes to complete and will ask you about your experience living and growing up in West Sussex, where you feel safe or unsafe and what you're concerned about in your day-to-day life. The survey will also ask for basic information such as your age and gender. The survey is completely anonymous and nothing you say can be linked back to you. This survey is voluntary - you do not have to take part. If you have any questions about the survey, your teacher/school will be able to give you more information.
