## West Sussex Youth Safety Survey

This survey goes live on 11<sup>th</sup> March until 25<sup>th</sup> March and children and young people in West Sussex can complete it at any time during this period.

There is NO cap on participation - West Sussex would like as many children and young people to have an opportunity to have their voice heard and inform the way in which services respond to the issues they face in their lives, particularly in different locations in West Sussex.
