## Exam Equipment

Please ensure your Year 10 student is equipped with a scientific calculator, pen, pencil, ruler, protractor and a pair of compasses. We aim to familiarise Year 10 with exam regulations and therefore all exams will be conducted in exam conditions. Students will need to leave their mobiles, air pods and any electronic device including any kind of watch in their school bags, which will be securely stored in the Wyatt Studio. Mr Case will be familiarising students with all exam procedures in advance of the exams.
