West Sussex County Council have confirmed that families with Free School Meal eligible children will once again be entitled to a voucher for each FSM child during the upcoming summer school holiday 2024.

FSM eligible families in West Sussex will be entitled to a single £50.00 voucher, per FSM child, to cover the summer holiday period.

For children who are not FSM eligible but whose families need urgent support with food in West Sussex, the Community Hub is operating.
