Dear Parents and Carers

Late arrival to school

I feel a need to begin my letter this week ruling out a misunderstanding about the start of a school day. Tutor time in the past, and maybe in the era when we were at school, used to be a time for chilling in a tutor base, chatting with friends and so on.

This is no longer what tutor time looks like. It is a 30-minute period of learning time, structured as a planned lesson important to a range of areas of a child's education. It is a **compulsory** part of the school day covering **compulsory** elements of curriculum.

Children who persistently arrive late to school miss valuable learning. Arriving late to school can also be embarrassing for them having to walk into the classroom late, it disrupts the learning of the rest of the class, it gives them a poor start to the day and they miss out on key notices given. Some students look visibly uncomfortable when they arrive late and have to ring the bell to gain access to site.

If your child arrives regularly late to school, please consider the impact on them and on others and make sure they have a regular routine for the start of the day, help them get their clothes and equipment ready before they go to bed and set a reasonable bedtime to make sure they get enough sleep. Please give your child a good start to the day. As I said last week, we are here to provide a great education to your child; we can't do this if they aren't here.

I would like to thank the vast majority of parents and carers whose children attend school well, are never late to school or to lessons and who are great ambassadors for Six Villages, upholding our core values daily. Thank you for your support.
