Telephone System Update

Equipment

As usual, please take a moment during half term to check your child has all the equipment they need for the next half term. Students will also need to have a black dry whiteboard marker in addition to their usual equipment.

Appointments during the school day

Whenever possible, please book medical or dental appointments outside of school hours. On the occasions when this cannot be avoided, please can you ensure that your child knows the time that they are being picked up to go to their appointment. Their teacher will then excuse them from the lesson at that time and they can come to reception to be signed out. There have been many occasions recently where it has been necessary to collect the child from the classroom which not only delays the child's departure from school, but at pinch points during the day there may not be an available member of staff which also causes a delay to the child leaving school.

There are many instances across the week when a parent comes to site to deliver a forgotten lunch, PE kit, violin, cooking ingredients or some other item. We appreciate you taking the time to bring these items. In the event that your child contacts you to let you know what they need, which I assume is done prior to arrival at school as phones are not allowed to be used during the day, please can you let your child know that they need to collect the item from reception.

Chichester Lit Quiz

Does your child love reading? Would they like the chance to represent our school in a book quiz against other local secondary schools? If so, please encourage them to come and take part in the qualifying book quiz on **Thursday 7**th **November, Period 5** in the library. They MUST sign up beforehand so their period 5 teachers know they will not be in their regular lesson. Students are encouraged to sign up quickly as limited places are available.

Singing Lessons

Year 11 Mock Exams

Mock exams begin on 11th November. It is very important for students to arrive at school punctually to ensure they do not miss the start of their exams. Students also require a full set of equipment in a see-through pencil case including ruler, protractor, a pair of compasses, black pen(s), pencil and scientific calculator. The link to the mock exam timetables is here.

Just a reminder also for students to ensure that they are chunking their revision, creating flashcards, practising past papers, and using the resources we have shared via Satchel. We recommend two 1-2 hours of revision each day of the holidays, focusing specifically on weaker topics in each subject area. Most students have shared that they will be revising in the mornings and then enjoying time with family and friends in the afternoons. Students can also access past papers via Revision World. Please also remind your Year 11 child of the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) Regulations opposite.

Students have been made aware already that a breach of regulations may lead to disqualification.

A. Regulations - Make sure you understand the rules

- 1 Be on time for all your exams. If you are late, your work might not be accepted.
- 2 Do not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the exam.
- 3 If you try to cheat, or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your exams.
- 4 You must not take into the exam room:
 - (a) notes;
 - (b) AirPods, Earphones/Earbuds, an iPod, a mobile phone, a MP3/4 player or similar device, a watch, smart glasses or any other smart device.

Any pencil cases taken into the exam room must be see-through

Remember: possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules, even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.

- 5 If you have a watch, the invigilator will ask you to hand it to them.
- 6 Do not use correcting pens, fluid or tape, erasable pens, highlighters or gel pens in your answers.
- 7 Do not talk to or try to communicate with, or disturb other candidates once you have entered the exam room.
- 8 You must not write inappropriate, obscene or offensive material.
- 9 If you leave the exam room unaccompanied by an invigilator before the exam has finished, you will not be allowed to return.

10 Do not borrow anything from another candidate during the exam.
