Your support with parking safely would be much appreciated; many thanks in advance.


#### Year 7 and Year 8 Disco

#### Reporting absence


# Free Youth Gym Launch

I have been asked to share the following with you:

"A new youth gym session exclusively for teenagers is to be launched in Arundel in February and it's absolutely free!

The sessions, which will run on Wednesday evenings from 5-6.30pm at Arundel Lido starting on  $12^{th}$  February, will include a varied exercise session to include weight training, circuits and other fitness and time to socialise.

It has been set up to provide activities for young people in the town following feedback that there isn't enough to do and is aimed at 14-17 year olds. They will run as a trial so we can work with the young people involved to shape them to meet their needs. They will only be able to continue if they are well attended.



Generously hosted by Arundel Lido with funding from the Town Council the sessions aim to give young people a space to get together, get fit and meet others. The sessions are completely free and include a free drink on the night. No need to book, just turn up and join in. They will be run by a qualified fitness instructor with a trained youth worker on site to support.
