### Red Nose Day – Wear it Red

A reminder that we will be holding a non-uniform day on <u>Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> March</u> to provide an opportunity for our school community to donate funds which will be shared equally between Comic Relief and Year 11 Prom.

Students have the option to wear non-uniform, in line with the theme 'Wear it Red' and need to bring a £1 donation into school which is payable in tutor time by <a href="https://docs.physics.org/">Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> March.</a> If you are in a position to donate a little more, it would make a great difference.



When your child is deciding on their clothing on 20<sup>th</sup> March, please can you ensure that they observe the following expectations, which apply to all students:

- 1. They must wear something red, eg. red t-shirt, red jumper, etc
- 2. Their clothing is to be safe and practical for stairs, and the classroom without language or slogans which may offend
- 3. Tops/t-shirts cover shoulders, chest and midriff
- 4. Footwear is safe for stairs and appropriate for school.
- 5. Normal rules for jewellery and face piercings apply due to health and safety

Any student not wearing suitable clothing will need to go back home and change. Please note that whilst we are aiming to raise funds, this will still be a normal school day of learning and full attendance is expected. This 'own clothes' day is optional and students are welcome to wear their school uniform.

There will be a tuck shop available in the Gate theatre on 20<sup>th</sup> March as well as other activities including putting teachers in stocks in the courtyard. If your child would like to visit the tuck shop or put a favourite teacher in stocks, they will need to bring some cash in on the day.
