This annual event will take place on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June, in the same format as previous parents' consultations this academic year. You will receive an automated email inviting you to book your appointments when the booking system opens at 6pm today.

## Early finish – Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June

Our Year 10 parents' consultation is taking place on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June and all students will finish at 1.10pm on that day.

The school buses have confirmed that they will collect students at 1.10pm. Passengers for the 500 bus will need to walk to the Eastergate War Memorial/Collins Close stop.

If your child catches a public bus, you will need to make arrangements to get them home.
