Energy drinks

I have written to you before outlining my concerns regarding our children purchasing energy drinks on the way to school and starting the day drinking this down on the way into school.

These drinks state on the cans that they are unsuitable for children. I have today gone to the local shops to discuss their selling of these products to children.

In the interests of your child's health and due to the stimulant compounds and high levels of sugar and acidity in these drinks, I would strongly urge you not to allow your child to purchase energy drinks, and you may wish to consider only allowing them funds on their school canteen drinks where healthy drinks are available. The NHS has stated that these drinks are "unnecessary" and "unsuitable" for children under 16.
