## Safeguarding notice

We have been made aware of a reported incident at a local park yesterday involving an adult approaching a group of our students. In short, a man, under the influence of alcohol, is reported to have approached the students and asked them to assist in stealing alcohol from a local shop. When the students rightly refused, the individual's behaviour reportedly became inappropriate. The students removed themselves from the situation immediately and alerted trusted adults back at home. The police responded very promptly and appropriate action was taken.

We are incredibly proud of how the students handled the situation and our designated safeguarding lead has met with identified students today to check on their welfare. Please ensure you have conversations with your children over the weekend to ensure they are aware of how to act in any such situation. We will reinforce your conversations over the coming days through assemblies and tutor times.

### **Open Evening**

I would like to issue a huge thank you to all students who volunteered to help at Open Evening yesterday. We have had overwhelmingly positive feedback on our student speakers, musicians, tour guides and department helpers. Visiting families have referred to them as being a credit to the academy. I'm sure you will agree it takes courage to perform or to speak in front of a large audience.
