Year 8 parents' consultation – Wednesday 28th January

A huge thank you to all of you who have already booked appointments with your child's subject teachers for next Wednesday. A reminder has been sent with the link to the system to those of you who have not yet made bookings. Please take a moment over the weekend to do this.

Uniform

Unfortunately, I must again raise issues around incorrect uniform items being worn to school.

I appreciate the support that the vast majority of families give in ensuring students attend school correctly dressed. However, despite previous reminders, we are continuing to see some students wearing items that do not meet our uniform requirements. It is therefore necessary to clarify expectations once again.

In particular, we are seeing:

- **Skirts made from non-approved fabrics** (including stretchy, jersey, leather-look, or fashion fabrics), rather than the required school-style fabric.
- **Flared, wide-leg or fashion-style trousers**, rather than plain, tailored trousers in a business style.

These items are **not part of our uniform** and do not meet the standards set out in our uniform policy. From Monday 26th January, students breaching our uniform policy will be required to either borrow our spare uniform or we will be asking you to bring the correct uniform into school. In many instances, students have the correct uniform but are choosing to wear lycra skirts, for example.

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Our uniform has been carefully designed to promote professionalism, equality and a strong sense of school identity, and it is important that it is worn correctly by all students.

Where there is uncertainty, we strongly encourage families to check with the school *before* purchasing new uniform items.

Thank you for your continued support in maintaining the high standards and positive learning environment that our students deserve.
